You will ONLY be responsible for graphics design and not Charts & Graphs contest content.

Our tactile graphics designer duties would include, but are not limited to:

- Knowledge of BANA Guidelines and Standards for Tactile Graphics.
- Ability to design tactile graphs/maps in accordance with BANA guidelines and standards.
- Ability to coordinate with contests transcriber for the purpose of editing graphic designs to ensure they match the braille contests.
- Ability to read print braille is helpful, but not required.
